- All-Hazards approach
- Unified Command
- Hurricane Katrina
 - >900 Firefighters & 200 pieces of apparatus to Louisiana
 - >300 Law Enforcement to Louisiana
 - >1,000 National Guard troops to Gulf Coast region
 - Two teams of Emergency Management personnel & Mobile Command post to Mississippi
 - >100 Central Management Services restore communications in region
 - IMERT with 51 doctors, nurses to Baton Rouge

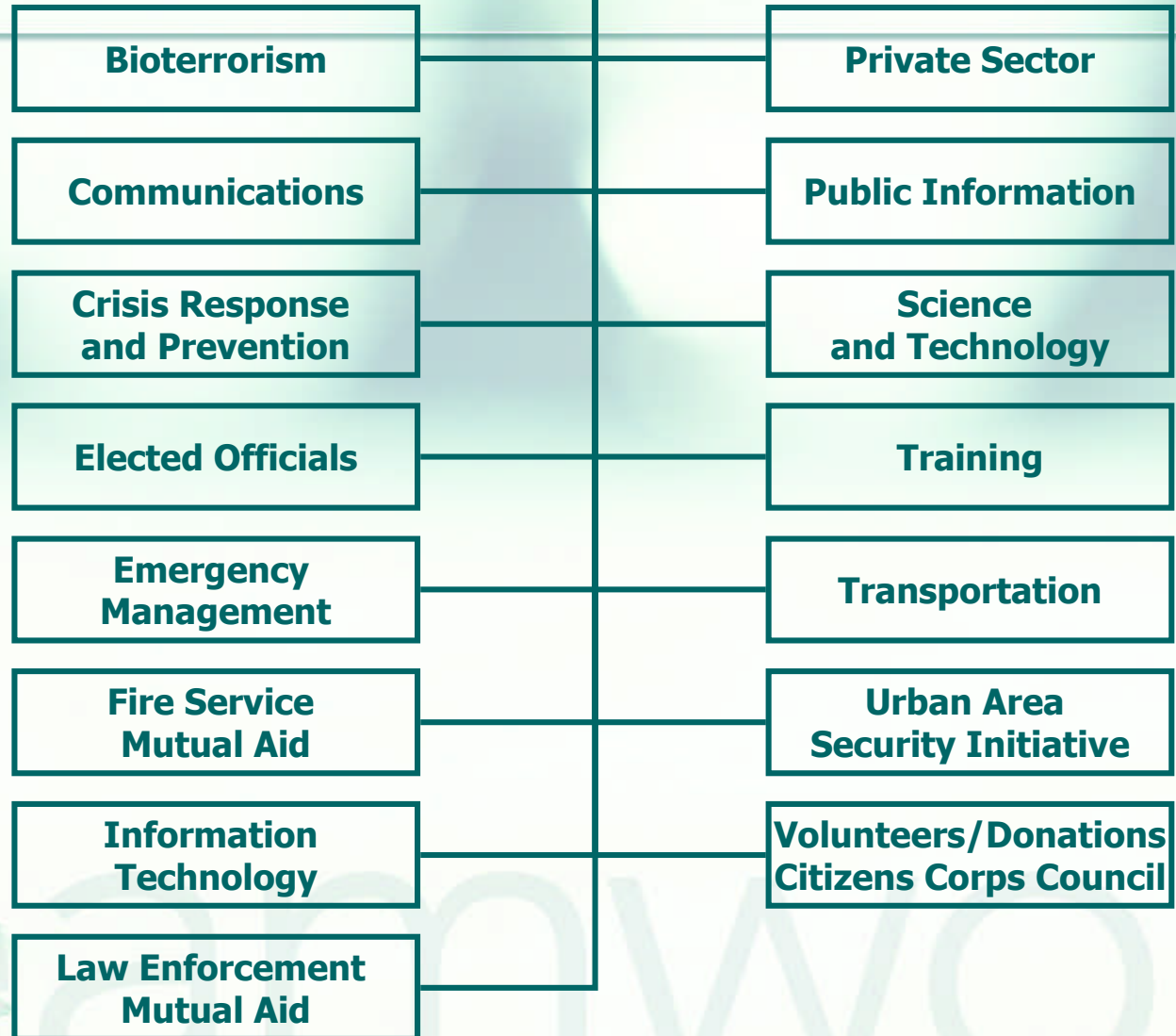

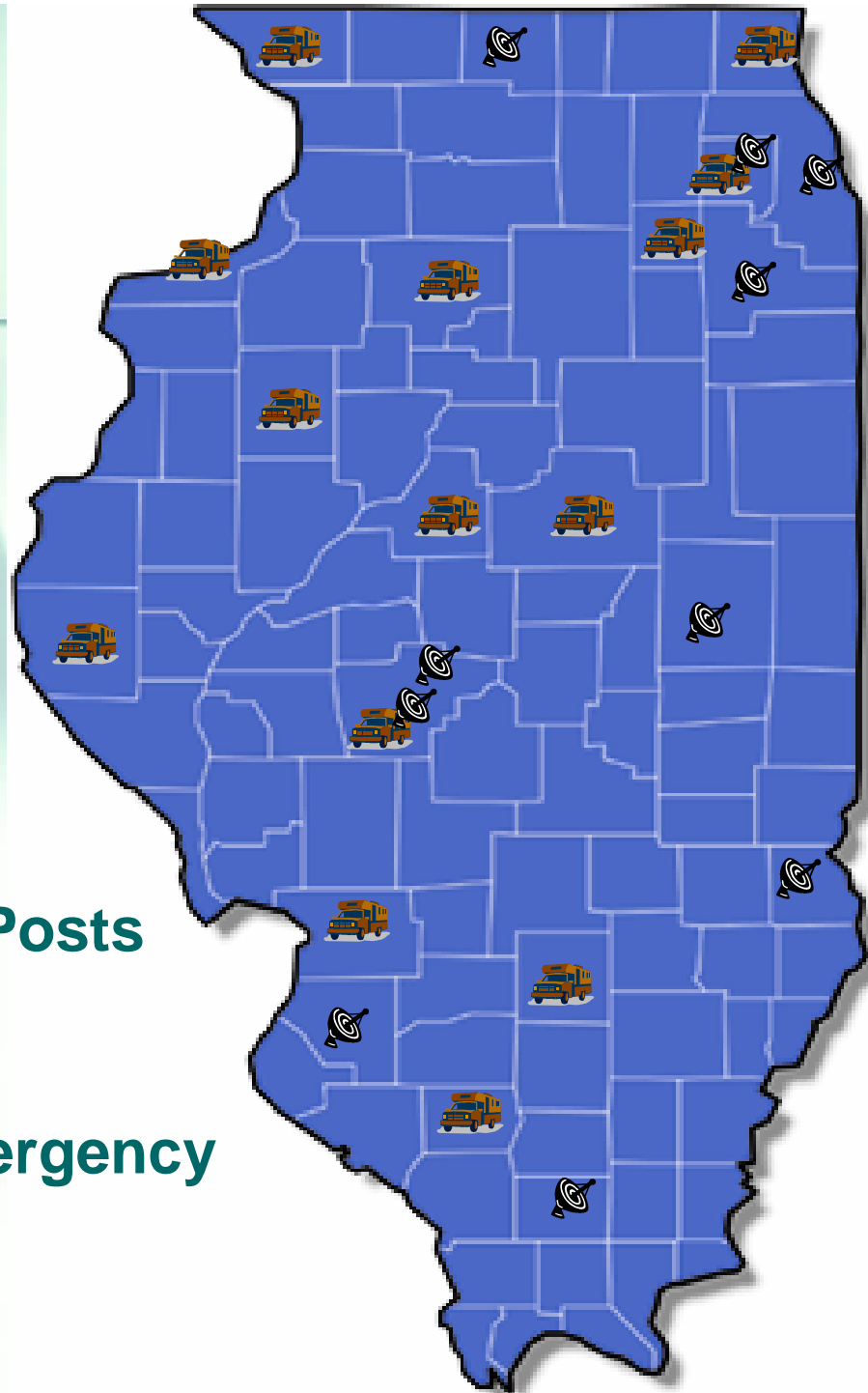


Mobile Unified Command Posts

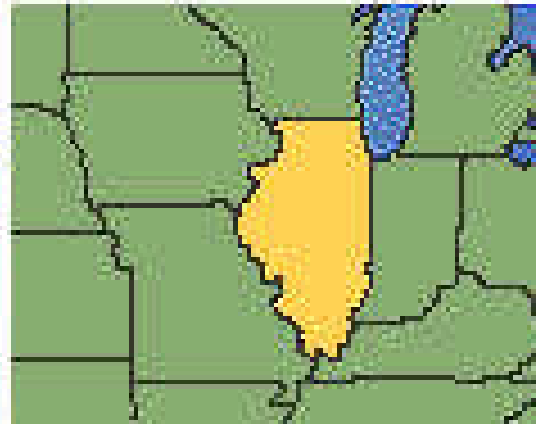
